Re: Tender of Grand Tax Payment — Loren R. Douglass

Dear Counsel Jordan:

Enclosed please find cashier's check no. 6642610714, drawn on Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. and dated May 15, 2026, in the amount of \$1,400.00 (One Thousand Four Hundred and 00/100 US Dollars), payable to Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity, Inc., tendered in payment of my Grand Tax obligation to the Grand Boulé of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity. I tender this payment in my capacity as a member of the Fraternity in good standing.

By email dated May 4, 2026, Sire Archon Shawn V. Austin of my member Boulé instructed me as follows: *"While there is ongoing litigation with the Grand, there is nothing that Zeta can do. Please refer all correspondence to the Grand."* The Austin instruction is the procedural basis for the direct tender of Grand Tax to the Grand Boulé rather than through the ordinary Zeta Boulé channel.

The enclosed instrument is a cashier's check drawn on certified funds. Cashier's check funds are certified by the issuing institution and require no bank clearing period. Receipt of the enclosed cashier's check by you as institutional agent of the Grand Boulé constitutes payment in full of Grand Tax as of the date and time of physical receipt.

This payment is tendered with full reservation of all rights and without waiver of any claim or position taken in pending proceedings, including the matter pending in the Court of Common Pleas of Philadelphia County (Orphans' Court Division) at O.C. No. 600 NP of 2025, in which the Court issued preliminary findings on September 16, 2025 that I am likely to prevail on the merits.

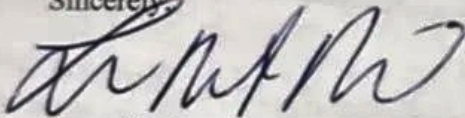
I require acknowledgment of receipt by return email within three business days of physical receipt of this letter, stating the date and time of receipt. Acknowledgment shall

loren.douglass@outlook.com with Jeffrey M. Scott, Esq., at jscott@archerlaw.com copied. Failure to acknowledge receipt within the specified window will be treated as evidence of evasion of the procedural obligations of the tender.

Within the same three-business-day window, I further require production of one of the following: (a) the Grand Board vote record authorizing the August 2025 administrative suspension of my membership, together with the specific provision of the Constitution, Bylaws, or Code of Conduct Policy and Grievances and Disciplinary Manual (2024) authorizing administrative suspension as a procedural device; or (b) written attestation that no Grand Board vote authorizing administrative suspension was taken, and acknowledgment that no provision in the governance documents authorizes administrative suspension. For the avoidance of doubt, the Grievance Committee's determination of August 7, 2025 states: *"The Committee sees no useful purpose to be served by recommending further action."*

I have also addressed correspondence of even date to Bennett Gaines, Executive Director, requesting confirmation that my membership has been administratively reactivated and is current in good standing upon receipt of the tendered payment. A copy of the Gaines correspondence is enclosed.
