◆ **THE PARLIAMENTARIAN**

James H. Slaughter, Past President of the American College of Parliamentary Lawyers, reviewed the governing documents and confirmed the ten-vote requirement in a written opinion.

◆ **THE GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE**

The Fraternity's own Grievance Committee reviewed the matter and found that no useful purpose would be served by recommending further action.

◆ **THE COURT**

A Pennsylvania Orphans' Court has issued preliminary findings that the 51st Grand Sire Archon is *likely to prevail on the merits*.

These are preliminary findings, not a final judgment. The matter is not concluded.
