Seize the Future!

The Long View: Where does it all lead?

Archons,

The inaugural Boulé Leadership Institute held last weekend was a resounding success. Hundreds of Archons—including Sire Archons, Sire Archons–Elect, and newly inducted Archons—joined sponsors and membership council chairmen in Miami for a weekend filled with intensive training, knowledge sharing, networking, and fellowship. We successfully raised \$500,000 for the Boulé Foundation, gaining clear direction and renewed sense of purpose and dynamism for our future endeavors.

Since my inauguration last June, our theme “**Seize the Future**” and its four pillars—Wealth Creation, Stronger Fraternal Bonds, Policy Influence, and Community Impact—have been at the heart of our Grand communications. We have advanced initiatives such as building a relationship ecosystem among Washington, D.C., Corporate America, and financial markets, launching the **Harvey Russell Institute of International Business & Strategic Coalitions**, and donating the **Josephine Baker** portrait to the U.S. Embassy in Paris, all of which are underpinned by a broader guiding framework. I have urged Archons across the country to carefully read my writings, saying, “I’m trying to tell you something.” This overarching vision shapes the initiatives and priorities I have been presenting for your consideration.

To avoid overwhelming or boring our readers, I have gradually introduced this vision through articles and newsletters. However, given recent events, we have decided to accelerate a comprehensive explanation for enhanced clarity, efficiency, and impact. **“The House is on fire!”** And the time for action is now.

At the core of our strategy is what I call the **Strategic Empowerment Doctrine**—a framework built on four interconnected, mutually reinforcing components:

- **Focused Political Engagement (Ecosystem Construction)**
 - Advocacy
 - House: Financial Services, Ways & Means
 - Senate: Banking, Appropriations
 - Executive: Treasury, Commerce (Agencies)
 - Campaign Participation (Finance)
 - Mobilization Finance

- **Targeted Economic Growth (Wealth Creation)**
 - Regulated Industry Focus
 - High Growth Business Formations
 - Procurement

- **Electoral Coalition Building (Policy Influence & Community Impact)**
 - Based on Shared Interests
 - Supported by Research and Thought Leadership

- **Global Soft Diplomacy (Global Relationship Building)**

- Trade Ambassador Program
- Arts and Cultural Exchanges
- Focus on Diaspora
 - Africa
 - Europe
 - Caribbean
 - Brazil

Integrated through close coordination between Russell Institute staff and key thought leaders, these components provide the roadmap for Sigma Pi Phi to become the consequential global force I described in my inaugural address. The **Strategic Empowerment Doctrine** offers an approach distinct from those pursued by other civil rights organizations. Instead of duplicating their efforts, it strategically complements them. While traditional civil rights groups tend to focus on broad-based membership and domestic issues, our approach—as implemented by the Russell Institute—is market-driven and global in scope.

Seize the Future exemplifies the doctrine's proactive, externally focused approach. It unfolds in three distinct phases: building our foundation, positioning for the future, and executing for the future.

The Path Forward

Implementation of **Seize the Future!** and its four pillars are envisioned in three phases: *Strengthen the Foundation*, *Positioning for Growth*, and *Launch for Future Prosperity*. We started our transformation in 2024 by establishing a solid foundation for the Office of the Grand Boulé and providing the technology backbone for greater Archon connectivity, collaboration, and internal operations. Additionally, we organized for enhanced Archon external influence and sustainable wealth building that is sorely needed for our future success. We launched the Russell Institute, a separate organization that provides interested Archons with a vehicle to collaborate effectively with non-Archons, women, and like-minded organizations.

Below are the three phases, the proposed time periods and of what's expected to be achieved.

PHASE 1: Strengthen the Foundation (2024–26)

- Build the fellowship
- Improve operations
- Engage with major influences (public and private sectors)
- Build sustainable wealth creation systems

PHASE 2: Position for Success (2026–30)

- Connect the diaspora
- Grow Black banks and businesses
- Address crisis of the Black male (Black Male Crisis Center)
- Implement global agenda (Black Davos: Economic, Health, Social)
- Champion programs that strengthen families (Food, Mental Health, Health, Arts)

PHASE 3: Launch for Prosperity (2030 and beyond)

- Build and self-finance global businesses
- Remove Black men from “endangered species” list
- Thriving families in growing communities
- Active relations within the global diaspora
- Boulé emerges as indispensable global influencer in diaspora communities

PHASE 1: Strengthen the Foundation (2024–26)

From now until the end of the biennium, we will systematically leverage the strengths built over more than a century. We will prepare our culture and fellowship for the long term sustained action that will be required of our leadership. Every initiative will align with the **Strategic Empowerment Doctrine** and **Phase 1** of our strategic plan through July 2026. While future Grand Sire Archons might establish different priorities based on their unique circumstances and vision, this roadmap ensures

that the **Russell Institute**—operating as an independent organization—will continue advancing the Black/Brown agenda for years to come.

PHASE 2: Position for Success (2026–30)

Upon the successful completion of the first phase, we anticipate a significantly enhanced ability to mobilize and act in unison. By consistently emphasizing our protocols and traditions, we will build the cohesion and muscle memory essential for effective collective action. With this strong foundation, we can then focus our energy on addressing critical challenges within the Black community—specifically, improving access to capital, strengthening families, and tackling the “crisis of the Black male.” Additionally, forging stronger connections with our African Diaspora brethren, as Africa emerges as the epicenter of economic growth, will empower Black businesses to seize new opportunities and drive meaningful growth initiatives.

PHASE 3: Launch for Prosperity (2030 and beyond)

With a strengthened operating foundation and clear progress in empowering our communities through enhanced economic opportunity and increased access to health, wealth, and capital, we will continue building robust communities anchored by thriving Black businesses with global growth opportunities and full participation in the American franchise. By cultivating strong relationships with strategic stakeholders in both the public and private sectors, and by reinforcing the internal fabric of the Black and Brown community, the family, we will be well positioned to broaden and deepen prosperity based on individual agency. This approach stands apart from, and complements, the mass protest movement strategy, which will always remain a viable option.

Mass action through individual agency is a natural evolution towards Archon Martin L. King’s vision of self-help as a pathway to personal dignity and community empowerment.

These phases are mutually reinforcing, with elements of the **Strategic Empowerment Doctrine** present in each stage. The timelines provided are not intended to represent strict start or end dates, as many initiatives

—such as *Grow Black Banks*—are already underway and will likely extend beyond the suggested timeframes. However, it is recommended that each initiative receives concentrated focus during its designated period to maximize impact.

Conclusion

The roadmap outlined above is a call for greater self-determination, grounded in my understanding of our most pressing challenges and the most promising opportunities for future prosperity. It emphasizes developing the “whole Archon” and rebuilding the support systems for the Black middle class—systems that are currently under pressure from global social, economic, and political trends. The **Russell Institute**, serving as a vehicle for collective action and global collaboration for Black and Brown prosperity—much like the Heritage Foundation—will yield deep and sustainable benefits for Archons who wish to participate, their families, and the rest of Black/Brown America. Embracing this long-term vision requires both imagination and faith in the power of markets to address community challenges. Ultimately, ***Seize the Future*** is more than a call to action for the Archons of Sigma Pi Phi; it is a framework for self-help and a tribute to the perseverance and resilience that have defined the African American community since our ancestors first set sail from West Africa in 1619.

Archon King muses in his famous quote from *Where Do We Go From Here: Chaos or Community?*:

“It is a cruel jest to say to a bootless man that he ought to lift himself by his own bootstraps.”

The **Strategic Empowerment Doctrine** not only ensures that he pulls himself up by his own bootstraps, but he also owns the entire boot factory employing scores of others who choose to do the same. That’s taking the long view of where this all leads. Let’s go there, together.
